

Operation Instructions

How to start your generator

Check / fill the engine oil STEP 1 Check / fill the fuel STEP 2 Place the circuit breaker in OFF STEP 3 position Open the fuel valve to the ON STEP 4 position Place the choke to the START STEP 5 position Turn the switch in the ON position (recoil start). Turn the key to the START position. Once the engine STEP 6 starts, release the key immediately (E-start) Pull recoil starter until engine runs (recoil start). STEP 7 Place the choke lever in the RUN STEP 8 position Connect the electrical devices. STEP 9 Turn the circuit breaker to the ON STEP 10 position

Disconnect all the electrical appliances one at a time.

Turn the key to the OFF position

Turn the fuel valve to the OFF position

What to check for if your generator will not start

STEP 1	Check the fuel and add if required.
	Observation will be self-and add if as existed. Discuss note
STEP 2	Check the oil level and add if required. Please note that these machines are fitted with a low oil alert sensor that will prevent the generator from starting if there is insufficient oil.

	Check that the spark plug is clean and not
STEP 5	black with carbon. Then check for spark.










What to check for if your generator has no power



What type of fuel does it use?

All standard grades of unleaded petrol are suitable for use in Maxwatt generators, including regular (91), premium (95), ultra-premium (98).
